The exhibition showcases STEAM-focused works, featuring a diverse collection of community-driven artworks, environmental reflections, and cross-cultural collaborations. The event marks the culmination of the Frugal Artists-in-Residence (FAiR) project led by AP Dr Jacey-Lynn Minoi of Universiti Malaysia Sarawak (UNIMAS), in partnership with Coventry University, UK, and in collaboration with the IEEE Sarawak Subsection and the Borneo Laboratory.
